



The ***Journal of Curriculum and Instruction (JoCI)*** is a peer-reviewed, open-access electronic journal that provides a forum for the dissemination of articles focused on research, practice, and related issues relevant to teaching and learning in the Pre K-12 environment. *JoCI* is supported by the College of Education at East Carolina University.

The audience for this journal includes higher education faculty, Pre K-12 teachers, graduate students in education, pre-service teacher education candidates, school administrators, and educational policymakers with an interest in curriculum and instruction. Contributors to the journal include classroom teachers, researchers and other practitioners from Pre K-12 schools, colleges, and universities.

*JoCI* welcomes submissions that are approximately 2,000 – 5,000 words. Manuscripts should include an information abstract of 100-150 words. Manuscripts should conform to APA style as outlined in the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (6<sup>th</sup> ed., 2009). Manuscripts that are of high quality, appropriate for *JoCI*, and adhere to the submission guidelines undergo a blind review process.

The editors of the *Journal of Curriculum and Instruction* welcome manuscripts that address topics related to current trends and issues in curriculum and instruction in Pre K-12 teaching and learning. Manuscripts submitted to *JoCI* should make a unique contribution to the knowledge base and be current, innovative, and applicable to the Pre K-12 environment. Manuscripts should be original, coherent, and understandable.

All manuscripts are peer-reviewed and are evaluated based on their innovation, quality of scholarship, and contribution to the field of curriculum and instruction. Submissions are accepted for the following journal sections:

**Research Forum** – This section includes qualitative, quantitative, and mixed methods research.

**Practitioner's Platform** – This section includes descriptions of professional practice and action research projects in PreK-12 settings that are supported by research literature.

**Perspective** – This section includes empirically-based commentaries, position papers, and policy analyses.
